Members of the GIFCT IAC are expected to be:

- Independent from GIFCT operating board members
 - In particular, members should not receive a significant proportion of their operating funding from GIFCT board members
- For those non-Governmental members, independent of Government
 - In particular, members should not receive a significant proportion of their funding from Government entities
- Independent of other IAC members
- Disengaged from operational law enforcement functions
- Possess relevant subject matter expertise in one or more of the following areas
 - Terrorism and/or violent extremism
 - Online content moderation at scale
 - Business and human rights
 - Internet governance
 - Free expression
- Able (with funding provided where appropriate) to travel to relevant GIFCT meetings and events
- Where members are seeking to speak on behalf of wider communities or groups of organizations, demonstrate how they are formulating their positions and consulting with their constituencies

Members will be appointed on an individual basis and able to provide a designated deputy in the event they are unavailable.

IAC meetings will be conducted in English.

Appointments will be made to reflect a diversity of subject matter expertise, geography, and community experience and perspectives.
